

Remembering Dr. Paul Merkley

It is difficult to put into words the lasting positive impact that Dr. Paul Merkley had on Harvest House. The many lives he blessed at Harvest House are a living testimony to his legacy.

For 32 years, he was a faithful member of the Harvest House board of directors. He also volunteered his time to teach an evening Bible study that had a great impact on the men in recovery at Harvest House.

"I met Dr. Paul Merkley in the early 1990s when we both served on the Chaplaincy Council at Carleton University. He immediately became interested in our



work at Harvest House Ministries when he realized that I was the founder's wife. His support for the ministry led to his serving on our Board of Directors and eventually accepting the position of President of the Board. Always a teacher at heart and a committed Christian, he subsequently offered his services teaching Bible Studies to the residents once a week for many years. He was faithful, a man of integrity, but also never failed to kindly remark when one missed an opportunity to let others know of your love for the Lord. He was a special person and one that I was blessed to know."



As a history professor, Dr. Merkley valued education and learning. He was a huge supporter of Harvest House's continuing education program. Whether someone was writing their high school equivalency exam, starting out in university, or beginning graduate school, Dr. Merkley was there to offer enthusiastic encouragement.
